- The e-learning platform is free of charge for the first 200 housing professional registrants in Wales who work for a local authority or housing association. We envisage the course modules being available to learners outside of Wales in the near future.
- We do share anonymised data with our funders and we are fully compliant with GDPR.
- All e-learner details will be kept confidential, safe and secure at all times.
- By registering and enrolling on the Welsh Zero Carbon Hwb e-learning platform, you will receive information about further training, newsletters, events and activities being run by the Hwb.

For the individual learner:
